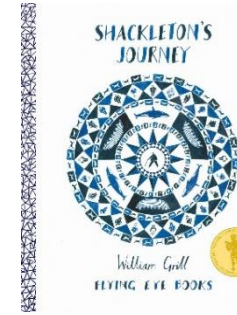
**Vocabulary**

- contrast:** A principle of art that refers to the arrangement of opposite elements (light vs. dark colours, rough vs. smooth textures, large vs. small shapes, etc.)
- landscape:** Where the main subject is a wide view
- wash:** A wash is a semi-transparent layer of colour. A wash of diluted ink or watercolour paint applied in combination with drawing is called pen and wash, wash drawing, or ink and wash.
- focal point:** the area of the composition to which the viewer’s eye is drawn to.

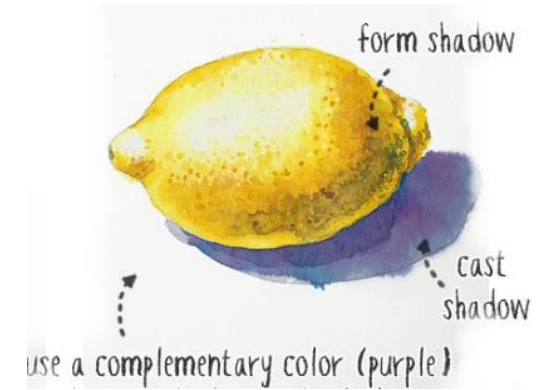
**Important People:**

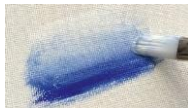
