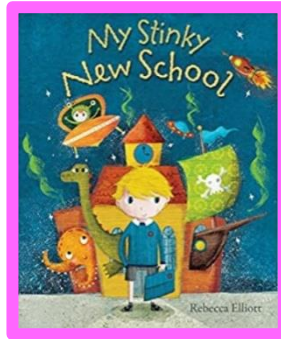
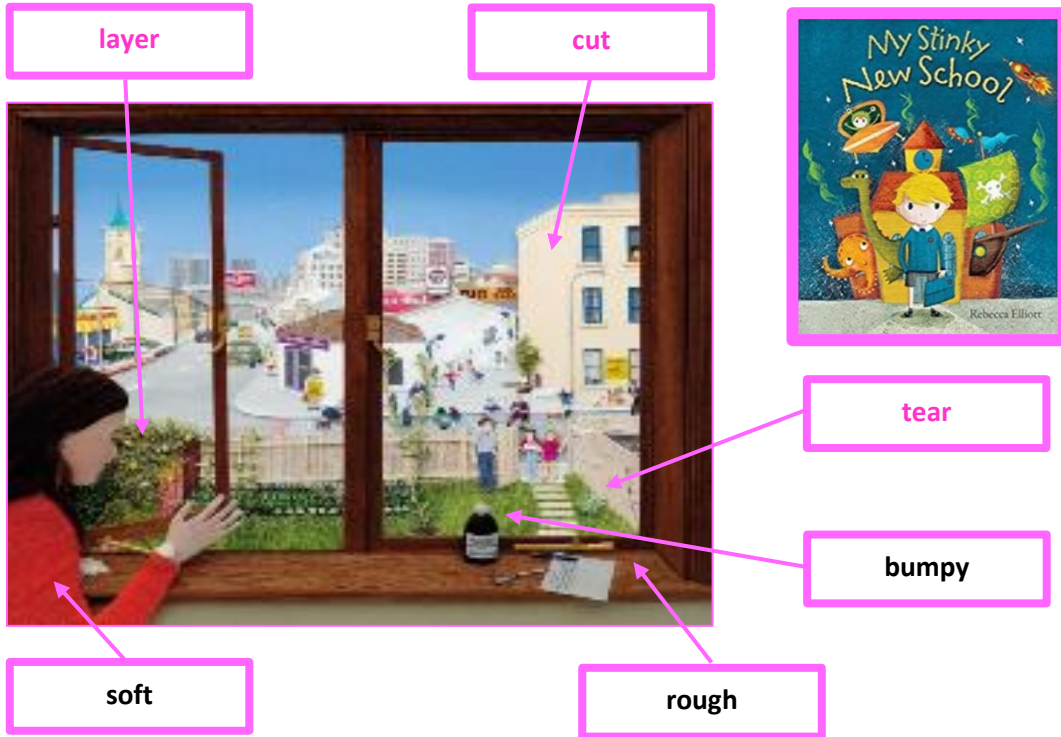


# “What makes my school special? (Collage)”



**Vocabulary**

**collage** - art made by sticking together different materials.

**cut** - to use scissors to make something smaller of a certain shape.

**layer** - put material on top of each other.

**tear** - to use hands to pull a material apart or into a different shape.

**texture** - how something looks and feels.
