



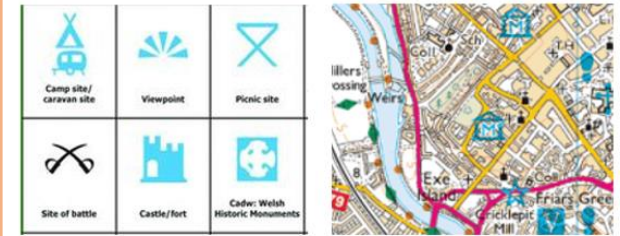

Important People

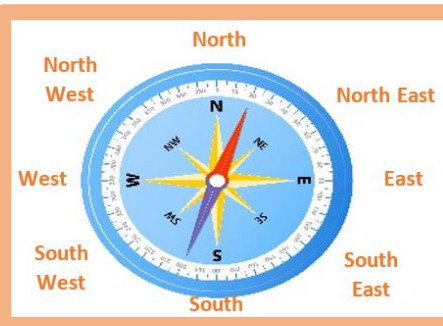
William Roy
