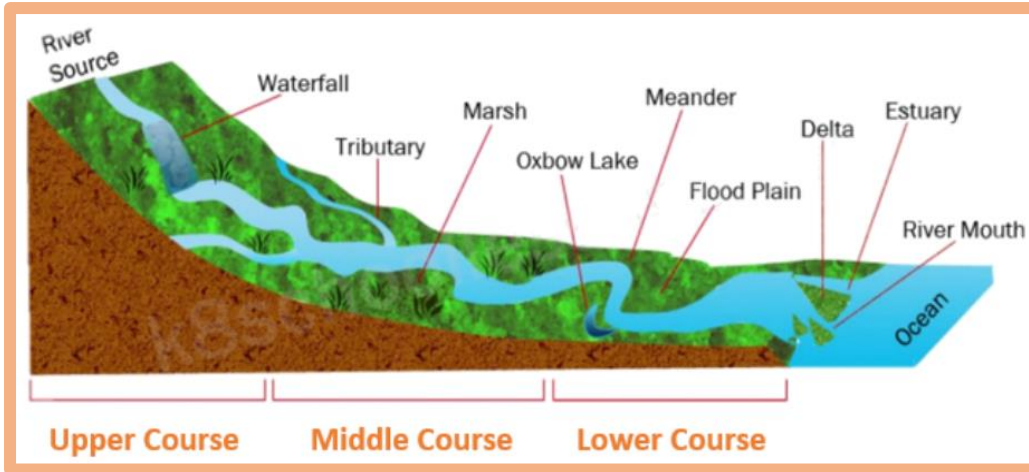

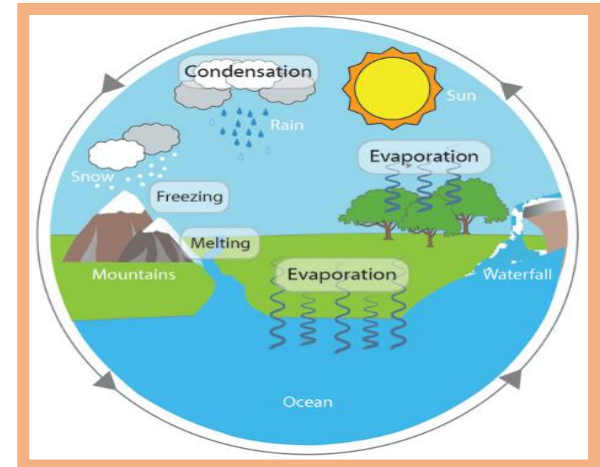
Important People

- The first person to describe the idea of the **water cycle**.

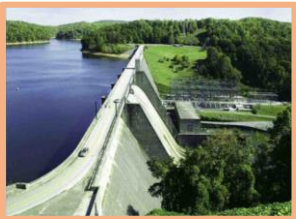
Big Ws: The water cycle



- **Rivers** are formed when **rain** flows down the hills, and they always flow **downhill** because of **gravity**.

Vocabulary

canal

Waterways built by people: used for shipping and transport.



confluence

Where two rivers meet.



lake

A large body of water that is surrounded by land and is not part of an ocean.



mouth

Where the river enters the sea.



river

A flowing, moving stream of water.



source

Where a river begins its journey.



stream

A small, fast flow of water.



tributary

A stream or river that flows into a larger stream or a lake.



valley

A low area of land with a river or stream flowing through it.
