intervention: when a human changes something and it has an impact – both positive and negative.

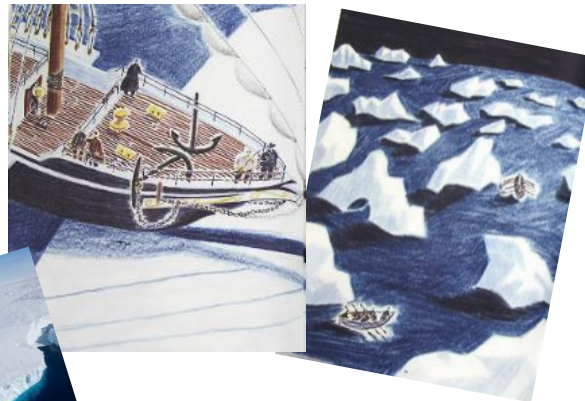
time zone: a place in the world that has the same standard time.
