- **Move the wooden carts** full of coal through the mine.

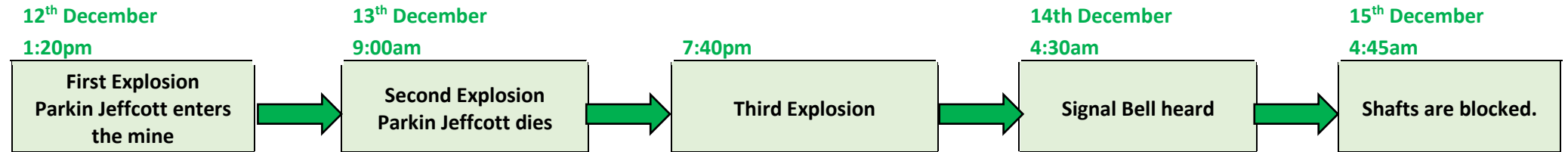
