- They might be **painted differently**, be **different shapes** or **different heights**.



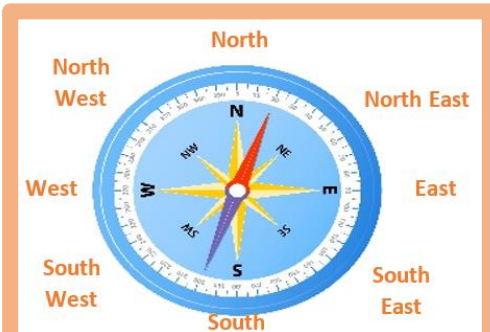

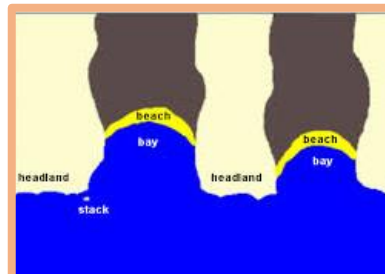

Big Ws: Headlands and Bays

- Crashing** of the waves **erodes** away the soft rock creating bays and beaches.
- Remaining hard rock areas are called **headlands**.
