


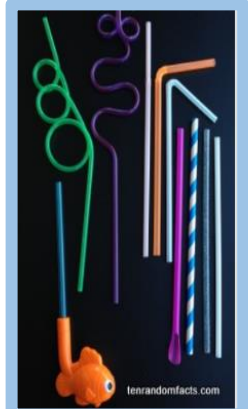
- Made the first **see-through plastic**.
